Happy holidays! In this thrilling installment of **Finest Burgundian Terroirs from The Principal**, **lots 1-308**, he evinces the finest Burgundian terroirs from **Rousseau**, **Romanee Conti** and **Roumier**, as well as newer stars such as



Olivier Bernstein and Prieure-Roch. Our articulate collector is always precise in his wine acquisitions, encompassing the very best vineyards in the region. He has made great investments in Burgundy as well as real estate by concentrating on the principle of location, location, location!!! Accordingly, he comes through splendidly with more than three hundred (300!) selections of primarily Red Burgundy spearheaded by a majestic 125 plus lots of Domaine de la Romanee Conti (many in original wood case), as well as White Burgundy, Bordeaux, Champagne, and Riesling. All the magnificent vineyards of DRC are present among the selections from THE Domaine, including the newest acquisition Corton, and the depth of rare magnums is impressive! Red Burgundy continues to reign with the aforementioned Domaines as well as Leroy, Dujac, and Faiveley, and white Burgundy is crowned by Bouchard, Coche-Dury, DRC Montrachet, and Domaine Leflaive. Additional highlights in our first King's realm include large format Bordeaux, Champagne from Krug, Salon and Bollinger, top Riesling, and some Italian gems to further augment the collection. This is a tremendous principal investment that banks on the principle of terroir in Burgundy. A great lesson, indeed! The rare large formats on offer are remarkable, especially all the magnums of Domaine de la Romanee Conti. La Paulee fans take note!!! All wines removed from professional storage for this anything but elementary collection.

Our second King, Royal Treasures of a Lifelong Burgundy Lover featuring Georges Mugneret-Gibourg with Dujac, Faiveley, Fourrier and Drouhin offers five hundred (500!) plus selections in lots 309-856. This connoisseur has Burgundy flowing through his veins and his finger on the pulse of the fine wine market. Nearly every lot here could be deemed a vinous treasure, the coverage and depth of producers, vintages, and rarities is amazing, and the tremendous amount of large format bottles is quite rare. Most wines were bought directly in France and when he bought at auction, it was often the largest collections at the biggest sales. There are nearly four hundred lots of Red Burgundy including a centerpiece of ninety selections from the tiny and adored jewel of Georges Mugneret-Gibourg crowned by a significant offering



of rare large formats. This is by far the greatest and largest selection of Georges Mugneret-Gibourg we have ever offered!!! This tremendous selection of Mugneret-Gibourg is complemented by a dozen selections of **Dujac**, twenty selections of **Faiveley**, a sweet sixteen of **Fourrier**, and two dozen lots of **Drouhin** amongst many, many others. The vast majority of wines stored in professional temperature-controlled storage with a small portion in the consignor's temperature-controlled home cellar. All in all, this featured collection is a French National Treasure, a spectacular collection of connoisseur's wines from Burgundy and beyond. A royal collection, indeed!

We march on with the third installment of **The Exceptional Cellar of John Tilson**, our third King featuring DRC, Leroy, Ancient Bordeaux, and Classic California. In lots 857-1072, it is our distinct honor and great pleasure once again to present over 200 selections from this exceptional cellar. Mr. Tilson has worn many hats through the years including being a prominent investment manager, longtime wine collector, and owner, founder, and editor of The Underground Wine Letter. John's sincere passion for wine and his outstanding wine tasting prowess is matched only by his lifelong appreciation for the finer things in life, which led him around the globe to experience the world's finest restaurants and unparalleled wine cellars. Back in the 1970s, he was welcomed at the top Chateaux in Bordeaux and the best Domaines in Burgundy and beyond, and he tasted many vintages straight from the barrel. Mr. Tilson was among the first to convince California wineries to allow him to do the same, obtaining the keys to the cellar of some of the most iconic Napa Valley estates. The red carpet of exceptional Red Burgundy continues with Dujac, Vogue, La Romanee, Clair-Dau, Georges Mugneret, Jean Gros, Mugnier, Meo-Camuzet, Arnoux, and Engel and white Burgundy proudly encompasses DRC Montrachet, Ramonet Montrachet, and Raveneau Les Clos! Truly Classic Cali back is highlighted by **Diamond Creek**, **Heitz**, **Inglenook**, and **Ridge**, and includes some of California's rarest older wines! John Tilson's exceptional cellar has been built over a half-century of tasting and collecting. The cellar itself is an impressive three rooms, all underground, kept dark and vibration free at 54 degrees with good humidity, just below the level of inducing mold. We are privileged and excited to represent this important collection of the finest wines on the planet for your bidding and drinking pleasure!
