We could not me more excited about this assortment of the best of the best of Burgundy direct from their cellars to yours!

In lots 459-669 we shine the spotlight on The Collection of Andrew Vacchiano featuring Dujac, Rouget, Roumier, Mugnier, Meo-Camuzet, Mugneret-Gibourg, and much more! Andrew's collection represents many of the first families of Burgundy, and that would be appropriate because he is big on family as well, always having great gatherings with both his family and his family of Burgundies. Andrew has lived a life in the financial world as a businessman and investment trader, and while his Burgundy collection has turned out to be a great investment, that was never the intention, but we finally talked him into sharing a few goodies - well, more than a few! He admitted that he loves the hunt for outstanding, rare wines, and part of continuing that hunt is to make room for more! Andrew has multiple homes all with significant climate-controlled cellars and has been collecting for decades. His first and foremost passion has always been Burgundy. We are ecstatic to welcome him to our La Paulée auction with over two hundred splendid selections focusing on 120 lots of Red Burgundy, and 91 more! The Red Burgundy collection includes sizable offerings of Vogue, Clos de Tart, Dujac, Rouget, Roumier, Mugnier, Meo-Camuzet, Mugneret-**Gibourg** and **Ponsot**. Star lots are so prevalent we can't possibly name them all. White Burgundy is short and sweet with Vogue Musigny Blanc and Lafon Montrachet. Bordeaux steps in with Cos d'Estournel, Latour and Vieux Chateau Certain while Chave and Jamet dominate the Rhone with large formats. Salon has magnums of its own, and we are pretty in Piedmont with Giacosa, Giacomo Conterno, and Gaja! This is a special collection from a special gentleman whose family values have translated well into the family of great wines here on offer. "Total Eclipse of the Palate," a kaleidoscope of top Burgundy, celebrates La Paulée in lots 670-1014 and is the sale's largest collection. This marks the triumphant return of The Eclipse Collection and includes over three hundred selections barely scratching the surface of our collector's mammoth cellar that eclipses 40,000 bottles! This offering is an A to Z of the finest wines, especially Red Burgundy. The quality here is also top of the mark as he has kept extensive records over his two decades of collecting, knowing the provenance of each and every bottle with a rarely seen precision. His collecting strategy was profoundly simple and immensely successful: to buy the best producers in the best vintages from the best sellers and cellars. Oh, and of course to focus on his favorite region of them all, Burgundy!!! Our New York City collector's interest in wine quickly turned into a passion and eventually the all-encompassing obsession that it is today. These were not investment pursuits, these were bought and selected with great love, care, and rigorous vetting as they were destined for his personal consumption. The rollcall of deep dive offerings from top producers continues with forty lots of Armand Rousseau, thirty selections of Comte Liger-Belair, more than two dozen lots of Leroy, eighteen selections of both Dujac and Roumier as well as ten from Henri Jayer and fifteen lots of Coche-Dury!!! We round things out with Haut Brion, Rayas, Chave, Dom Perignon, Selosse, **Krug** and **Monfortino** Riserva! This intense glimpse into the remarkably brilliant Eclipse Collection will leave your palate speechless after this total Eclipse!

Things keep rolling along in **lots 1419-1524**, **A Superlative Collection of Armand Rousseau**, all purchased directly from the Domaine over the years, including many magnums. This collection is all Armand Rousseau all the time and comes to us courtesy of a European gentleman who snuck in to our La Paulée debut just before the auction deadline. He offers us over one hundred lots acquired directly from the Domaine itself unmoved until now! Wow!!! More than thirty lots of Chambertin are highlighted by a twenty-three vintage vertical arching over 1994 to 2018. Clos de Beze is the perfect foil with more than thirty lots of its own and Clos St. Jacques gets its due with two dozen selections. We are ecstatic to offer this superlative collection of Armand Rousseau with perfect provenance from this European cellar!

The Emperor is back again in lots 1525-1705 in "The Emperor Reigns Supreme." It is with great honor that we again present to you iconic selections from the significant collection of The Emperor!!! The Emperor has hosted many epic wine evenings with endless fine and rare wines from his temperature-controlled cellar. The DRC show stars a dozen lots of Grand Echezeaux back to 1971, more than two dozen selections of La Tache including 1971 in bottle and magnum, five lots of Richebourg, and ten selections of Romanee Conti, Romanee Conti back to a magnum of 1971 with three bottles of 1988 and six bottles of 1990!!! The red carpet of finest Red Burgundy continues with Leroy, Jayer, Dujac and Roumier, who features some super special lots with Bonnes Mares and Musigny from 1971, bottles of 1993 Musigny, and



a magnum of 1999 Musigny!!! A sweet sixteen selection of **Coche-Dury** paves the road to White Burgundy gold for a dozen fantastic lots of DRC Montrachet, nine vintages of **Leflaive** Montrachet spanning 1993 to 2008, and **Ramonet** Montrachets spearheaded by a bottle of 1979 and a Jeroboam of 1992!!! Don't forget about the **Rayas** and **Screaming Eagle**! This collection has something for everyone, for everyone who is drinking the finest and rarest wines in the world!!!
