The acidity is well judged and I noticed that after two or three hours, there was a faint vein of graphite that lends it a Pauillaclike personality, no surprise given that it lies just across the border. It will require several years in bottle for the tannins to mellow, but the result will be a very attractive. quite correct, fresh and precise Cos d'Estournel that will bestow two or three decades of drinking enjoyment. NECK:

Normal level for all wines. In wines over ten years of age, this level suggests excellent provenance. Rarely used, except to emphasize a particularly good fill level when other fill levels in the same lot are less than perfect.

BASE NECK:

A common fill level at which many Châteaux release their wine. For wines of any age, this level suggests excellent provenance.

TOP-SHOULDER:

Again, a common fill level at which many Châteaux release their wine. For wines of any age, this level suggests excellent provenance.

VERY HIGH SHOULDER:

Acceptable fill level for wines twenty years of age. Suggests proper storage conditions throughout its life. Natural occurrence for wines of this age.

HIGH SHOULDER:

Usually not a problem for wines thirty years of age. This level may be caused by easing of the cork combined with natural evaporation. Check the clarity and the color of the wine in the bottle as a secondary indicator of provenance.

HIGH-TO-MID-SHOULDER:

Refer to High Shoulder and Mid-Shoulder level descriptions.

MID SHOULDER:

May suggest ullage during the life of the wine due to either easing of the cork or inconsistent storage conditions. Not abnormal for wines forty or more years of age. As additional indicators of risk, definitely inspect clarity and color of the wine in the bottle, as well as condition of the cork.

LOW SHOULDER AND BELOW:

Suggests poor provenance. Definitely a risk and generally not saleable, with exception given to rare bottlings and/or labels. (Not recommended for consumption.)

Because the shape of Burgundy bottles does not allow for a level rating system based on the shoulder of the bottle, levels are described by means of centimeters below cork. Generally, Burgundy wines with a four centimeter fill level or above are considered normal for wines younger than twenty years. Wines of twenty or more years of age with fill levels of between four and five centimeters are generally considered to be of sound provenance, though consideration should be given to the clarity and color of the wine in the bottle, as well as the condition of the cork. Bottles with ullage between five and seven centimeters are not uncommon for wines forty years and older and often provide thrilling drinking, but the lower the fill, the higher the risk, so consideration should be given. Burgundy bottles with fill levels lower than seven centimeters may be at risk of being damaged or undrinkable, and therefore may be unsaleable. It should be noted that some Burgundian producers tend to over-fill their bottles during the bottling process which may cause a few drops of wine to become trapped between the capsule and the cork. This should not be confused with ullage, a natural occurrence in older wines, which may be accelerated due to poor provenance.

f) 買方的彌償保證。買方就因(i)買方違反或指稱違反本協議的任何保證或違反本協議:(ii)買方根據或就本協議送達的任何證書、 文件或文據的任何不確之處:及(iii)買方、其代理人或僱員對財 產造成不利影響的任何行為或遺漏而引起的任何損失、開支(包 括須預先支付的律師費及開支)、法律責任、成本或損害賠償, 向AMCA、其人員、董事、僱員及代理人彌償、為其進行辯護及 使其免受損失。買方的聲明、保證及彌償保證將在本協議擬進行 的交易完成後仍然有效。

g)版權。AMCA保留其自行或由其代表提供的所有影像、圖示及 書面材料,包括但不限於本目錄的內容(統稱「材料」))的版權,且在任何情況下,買方或任何第三方在未取得AMCA 的事先書面同意下不得使用任何材料。在任何情況下,AMCA或 賣方就買方將取得任何財產的任何版權、複製權或任何其他知識 產權概不作出任何聲明或保證。

6. 一般條款。

a) 標題。本銷售條款的分條標題僅為方便參考而設,不應視為本協議的實質部份。

b) 完整協議。本協議(包括所有以提述方式收納的文據) 構成 AMCA與買方就本協議主題的完整協議並取締雙方之間的任何及 全部較前的討論及協議。本協議不得作修改,而本協議任何部份 概不得獲授任何豁免、變動、更改、同意或解除,惟AMCA及買 方雙方以書面簽立的文據作出者除外。AMCA未有執行本協議的 任何規定並不構成對該規定作出豁免。

c) 無聯營關係。本協議的條文概不得解釋為AMCA與買方設立任 何代理、合夥或其他聯合企業。

d) 管限法律。本協議受香港法律管限,並按其詮釋及執行,而不援引規管法律衝突的原則。

e) 爭議解決。根據或就本協議條款的詮釋或應用或其任何引伸 或更改或任何一方的聲稱違反所引起的任何及所有爭議或爭論, 將通過在提交仲裁通知時生效的《香港國際仲裁中心機構仲裁 規則》在香港作出最終及具約束力的仲裁而解決。仲裁員為一 名,而仲裁程序將以英語進行。任何如此獲委任的仲裁員除可 判被發現已違反本協議的一方支付實際的金錢上損害賠償(但 非懲罰性損害賠償)外,亦將獲賦權在其裁決中授出強制性或 其他類型的衡平法補救方法、執行本協議的強制履行,及防止 任何持續或進一步違反其條款。所作仲裁裁決的判決可登記於 當地具司法管轄權的任何法院。該仲裁費用將由雙方平均分 擔,惟各方須負責其本身的律師費。

7. 語言。

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BUYER'S CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. BUYER'S AGREEMENT.

By bidding at auction, the bidder at auction ("Bidder") agrees that these Buyer's Conditions of Sale ("Conditions of Sale"), together with the Collection and Shipment of Wines, Bottle Description and Absentee Bids, all published by Acker, Merrall & Condit (Asia) Limited ("AMCA"), and all incorporated into the Conditions of Sale, constitute Bidder's entire agreement (the "Agreement") with AMCA and the seller ("Seller") with respect to the property ("Property") listed in this catalogue. AMCA may unilaterally amend the Agreement from time to time and at any time before, during and after any auction through posted notices, addenda, or errata or through oral salesroom announcements during the sale. By bidding at auction, Bidder agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions of the Agreement as may be in force from time to time.

2. AMCA AS AGENT.

Except as otherwise stated in the Agreement, AMCA acts strictly as agent for the Seller. The Agreement for the sale of all Property is therefore between Seller and the highest Bidder accepted by the auctioneer ("Buyer"). Property is divided into separate groupings as solely determined by AMCA and each such grouping (a "Lot") is subject to a separate bid at auction.

3. BEFORE AUCTION.

a) Inspection. Prior to auction, Bidder is expressly advised to physically inspect any Property for which Bidder is interested in bidding and to rely solely on such inspection, as opposed to descriptions of the Property in the catalogue or elsewhere. While AMCA attempts to describe all Property with accuracy, AMCA shall in no event be liable for any oral or written description of Property, or for any errors or omissions relating thereto. ALL PROPERTY IS SOLD "AS IS".

AMCA may, but shall not be obliged to, seek views of outside experts either before or after the sale of certain Property.

The auction venue has not selected or inspected any Property to be sold at this auction and disclaims any and all responsibility therefor.

b) No Guarantee. In no event whatsoever do Seller or AMCA or any of their respective officers, employees or agents make any oral or written express or implied representations, warranties or guarantees as to the merchantability, fitness for a particular use, the correctness of any catalogue description or other description as to the origin, physical condition, quality, rarity, authenticity, attribution, value, estimated value, importance, provenance, exhibition history, potability, historical relevance or bibliographic references concerning any Property.

c) Bidder Registration. To bid at this auction, Bidder must complete and sign a registration form and provide any information requested therein as well as the Bidder's proof of age. AMCA may also require that Bidder produce bank or other financial references confirming the availability of the Bidder's funds. AMCA retains the absolute right to refuse any prospective Bidder admission to, or participation in, any auction. Upon request, Bidder will provide government identification.

d) Importation. Buyer is expressly advised to read the Collection and Shipment of Wines form, which is incorporated hereto as part of this Agreement. Various jurisdictions may prohibit the importation, or limit the quantity, of alcoholic beverages that may be brought or shipped into such jurisdiction. In addition, various jurisdictions may require Buyer, Seller, or shipper to possess certain licenses or permits. Moreover, local laws may prohibit the importation and/ or the resale of wine. It shall be the Buyer's sole responsibility to determine if such prohibitions, restrictions, or limitations are applicable to Buyer and to determine before bidding at auction whether, and in what manner, alcoholic beverages can legally be brought into any jurisdiction. The prohibition or denial of, or delay in obtaining, any such permit or license shall neither justify the rescission of any sale nor any delay in making full payment for the purchase.

e) Exportation. Property sold at auction may be subject to laws governing exportation from Hong Kong. It shall be Buyer's sole responsibility to determine – before bidding at auction – whether an export permit or license is required for Buyer's purchase and to obtain any such required permit or license. The denial of, or delay in obtaining, any such permit or license shall neither justify the rescission of any sale nor any delay in making full payment for the purchase.

f) Absentee Bidding. Bidders are expressly advised to read the Absentee Bids form, which is incorporated hereto as part of this Agreement. As a courtesy to Bidders who are not present at the auction in person and are not attending the auction through an agent or by telephone, AMCA will enter written absentee bids which are delivered to AMCA prior to the auction. Such absentee bids must be placed in the currency of the place of sale. The entry of written bids is a free service offered strictly as an accommodation to Bidders and is undertaken by AMCA subject to its obligations at the time of auction. For the avoidance of doubt, AMCA shall not be liable for any errors or omissions in executing such written bids or for any failure to execute any such bids.

g) Telephone Bidding. Prior to the day of auction, Bidders may make arrangements with AMCA to bid at auction by telephone. Telephone bidding is offered as a courtesy to Bidders who cannot be present at the auction in person, by agent, or by written absentee bid. The entry of telephone bids is a free service offered strictly as an accommodation to Bidders and is undertaken by AMCA subject to its obligations at the time of auction. Accordingly, AMCA is in no event. For the avoidance of doubt, AMCA shall not be liable for any errors or omissions in executing such telephone bids or for any failure to execute any such bids.

4. AT AUCTION.

a) Catalogues. Bidders are expressly advised to read the Bottle Description form, which is part of this Agreement. While AMCA has attempted to describe each Lot in this catalogue accurately, in no event shall AMCA be liable for any description or error or omission in such description. AMCA retains the absolute right to amend at any time prior to and during the auction and in any manner any description of any Lot. Classifications in the text are for identification purposes only and are based on standard sources. Each statement contained in this catalogue and each other statement, whether oral or written, and whether made in an advertisement, bill of sale, addendum, notice, announcement, or other written or oral communication, is a statement of opinion ONLY and shall not be relied upon by any Bidder. Bidders must make appropriate allowances for natural variations of ullages, conditions of cases, labels, corks, and wine. In no event shall AMCA accept a return, offer credit for, or adjust the price of any Property after delivery except under the terms stated in Section 5 (d) below. Images appearing in this catalogue or elsewhere are for illustrative and informational purposes only and may not reveal defects or imperfections in any Lot. Bidders are urged not to rely on catalogue entry and to personally inspect any Property prior to placing bids.

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b) Reserve Price. Each Lot is sold subject to a reserve price, which is the minimum price which the Lot would be sold for. If the highest bid for the Lot is less than the reserve price, the Lot will not be sold. While AMCA has the right to raise or lower the reserve price at any time prior to the time the Lot is opened for bidding, under no circumstance shall the reserve price for a Lot exceed the low estimate for that Lot as printed in the catalogue or as amended by oral or posted notices.

c) Estimates. Each Lot in the catalogue is accompanied by a low and high estimate of the selling price, excluding the Buyer's premium and any applicable taxes. Bidding by employees of AMCA and its associates. No Liability. In no event shall AMCA be liable for any errors in entering any bids or for failure to enter any bids, and Buyers expressly agree to indemnify AMCA of such liability. After passage of title, AMCA shall bear no liability for risk of loss or damage to Lot(s). Buyer shall be required to obtain their own adequate insurance coverage for the Lot(s).

e) Parcel Lots. In the event the catalogue lists a sequence of Lots carrying the same estimates and consisting of the same type of wine, quantity, and bottle size (a "Parcel"), Buyer of the first Lot in such Parcel may, in the discretion of the auctioneer, be granted the option to buy any or all additional Lots in the Parcel for the same hammer price if there are no higher absentee bids on any subsequent Lot within the Parcel. - ix. Not permit Buyer directly or indirectly to participate in future AMCA or its associates' auctions;
- x. Exercise any right or remedy against Buyer available to Seller; and/or
- xi. Release the name and address of the Buyer to the Seller to enable Seller to commence legal proceedings against Buyer to recover all amounts due.

f) Buyer's Indemnity. Buyer shall indemnify, defend, and hold AMCA and its officers, directors, employees, and agents, harmless from any loss, expense (including attorneys' fees and expenses, which shall be paid in advance), liability, costs, or damages incurred by reason of

(i) any breach or alleged breach of any warranty herein or breach of this Agreement by Buyer,

(ii) any inaccuracy of any certificate, document, or instrument, or

(iii) any act or omission of Buyer, its agents, or employees, adversely affecting Property. Buyer's representations, warranties, and indemnification survive completion of the transactions contemplated in this Agreement.

g) Copyright. AMCA and its associates reserves copyright in all images, illustrations and written material produced by or on behalf of AMCA, including, without limitation, the content of this catalogue (collectively, "Material"), and in no event may Buyer or any third-party use any of Material without AMCA's prior written consent. In no event do either AMCA or Seller make any representation or warranty that Buyer will acquire any copyright, reproduction right or any other intellectual property right in any Property.

6. GENERAL TERMS.

a) Headings. The section headings in this Conditions of Sale are for convenience of reference only and shall not be considered as substantive parts of this Agreement.

b) Entire Agreement. This Agreement (including all instruments incorporated by reference) constitutes the entire agreement between AMCA and Buyer pertaining to the subject matter hereof and supersedes any and all prior discussions and agreements between them. Unless otherwise expressly provided for in this Agreement, this Agreement may not be amended, nor shall any waiver, change, modification, consent, or discharge of any part of this Agreement be granted, except by an instrument in writing executed by both AMCA and Buyer. Any failure by AMCA to enforce any provision.

c) No Joint Venture. No provision of this Agreement shall be construed to create any agency, partnership, or other joint enterprise between AMCA and Buyer.

d) Dispute Resolution. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong. The laws of Hong Kong (without regard to its conflicts of law principles) shall apply to any disputes arising in connection with this Agreement. The place of arbitration shall be Hong Kong. The arbitration shall be conducted by one (1) arbitrator appointed in accordance with the HKIAC Administered Arbitration Rules. The language of the arbitration shall be English. All documents submitted in the course of the arbitration shall be in the same language. The parties agree that the arbitration proceedings, including all documents, evidence, and submissions presented, shall be kept confidential. The award rendered by the arbitrator(s) shall be final and binding upon both parties. The parties agree to abide by and comply with the award without delay. The prevailing party in any dispute shall, in addition to any other relief, be entitled to recover its expenses and disbursements (including reasonable legal fees and expenses) from the non-prevailing party. To the extent practicable, the Parties agree that they shall attempt in good faith to resolve any disputes amicably without resorting to arbitration.

1. LIMITATIONS ON IMPORTATION

Bidders at auction ("Bidders") should be aware of restrictions imposed by various jurisdictions regarding importation of alcoholic beverages. It is the sole responsibility of the buyer ("Buyer") to investigate, apply, obtain, route, and comply with all special permit or license requirements and other restrictions prior to collection or shipment of wine ("Property") purchased at or from Acker, Merrall & Condit (Asia) Limited ("AMC"). AMC assumes no obligation or responsibility for obtaining permits or licenses on behalf of Buyer prior to shipment, and disclaims all liability for Buyer's failure to obtain any such permits or licenses. AMC is not the owner or seller of Property ("Seller"), but is a marketing agent which makes delivery arrangements on Buyer's behalf. Bidders are urged to familiarize themselves with their jurisdiction's importation laws prior to bidding at auction to determine if, when, and how Property may be legally delivered to their jurisdiction.

2. COLLECTION OF PROPERTY

Complimentary pick-up is available by appointment only. Please schedule pick-up by contacting AMC directly at shipping@ ackerasia.com at least one week in advance. Property will not be released until payment in full has been received and funds have cleared. Buyers paying by personal cheque should allow five business days prior to release of Property.

AMC shall also bear no liability or responsibility for the condition including deterioration of any casks, barrels, portion thereof or the liquid held inside the cask or barrel offered for sale at auction; and in no event will AMC be liable for any risk of loss as well as well as any special, consequential, or exemplary damages related to the purchasing of cask(s). Furthermore, casks(s) listed for sale by AMC are usually located in Scotland. Therefore, if Buyer chooses to bid for a cask(s), Buyer will be solely responsible for assuming title to the cask(s), storage and bottling of the cask(s).

If the purchased Lot(s) are located at Acker's Valley Cottage, New York warehouse, Buyers, within sixty (60) days of the date of the auction, must make arrangements for the delivery or pick up of the Lot(s). If Buyers do not make arrangements for the delivery or pickup of such Lot(s), Buyers will be charged a storage fee of twenty-five dollars per unit purchased (USD\$25 per/unit). In no event shall AMC have any liability to Buyer or any other party for any loss or damage to Property not collected within thirty (30) days following the auction date.

5. SHIPPING

Buyer is solely responsible for the shipment of Property and shall assume all obligations for compliance with applicable laws. Subject to applicable laws, at Buyer's request, AMC may act as an agent to engage a common carrier to deliver Property to Buyer on Buyer's behalf.

Shipping will be at Buyer's expense, and must be prepaid or freight collect. Shipments are also subject to service charges. Shipping arrangements can be made once payment has been received in full and funds have been deposited into AMC's account. Buyers should allow five business days when arranging shipment within Hong Kong, and ten business days for international shipments, which may require customs documentation or special routing attention.

AMC is not responsible for any deterioration, damage or loss to Property occurring while in transit.

6. TAXATION

Taxation is determined by the laws of the final destination of shipment. It is Buyer's responsibility to ensure compliance with applicable tax laws for shipments.

Buyers holding resale licenses may be exempt from taxation and should present the required documents to AMC prior to purchase.

Some jurisdictions may also impose excise taxes on shipments of Property into their territory. AMC may collect such excise taxes from Buyer, where required.

7. INDEMNIFICATION

Buyer agrees to indemnify, defend and hold AMC harmless from any and all demands, claims, suits, judgments, or other liability (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses incurred by AMC in connection therewith) arising by reason of Buyer's breach or Buyer's failure to pay any applicable taxes. This indemnification shall survive the termination of this Agreement

Insurance coverage on shipping does not cover confiscation by any government or law enforcement agency as a result of alleged violations of applicable laws by Sellers or Buyers.
